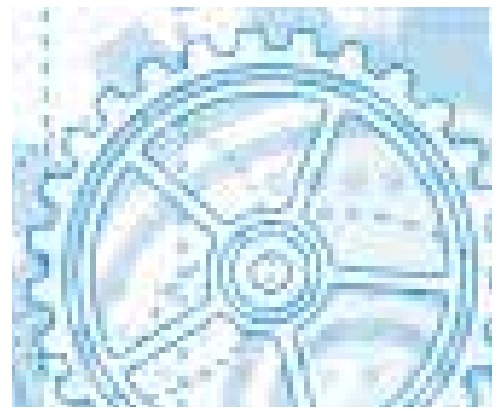


INNOVATIONS IN TEACHING

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

Criteria for the SPCS Innovations in Teaching award are outlined in the Innovations in Teaching document prepared by the Adjunct Faculty Advisory Committee (AFAC). The document was presented to the SPCS faculty during the September 13, 2013 faculty meeting. All aspects of the Innovations in Teaching document will be considered in determining the recipients.

CRITERIA OF AWARD

- Adjunct faculty member in SPCS
- Exhibits high level of innovation in the classroom
- Generates impact on student learning
- Role model for other faculty
- Exhibits creativity in the classroom

Nomination Information

Two or more people may collaborate on the nomination.

Nominations for the Innovations in Teaching award can be made by an adjunct faculty member, Chair of the various departments at SPCS, SPCS student or other SPCS faculty members.
