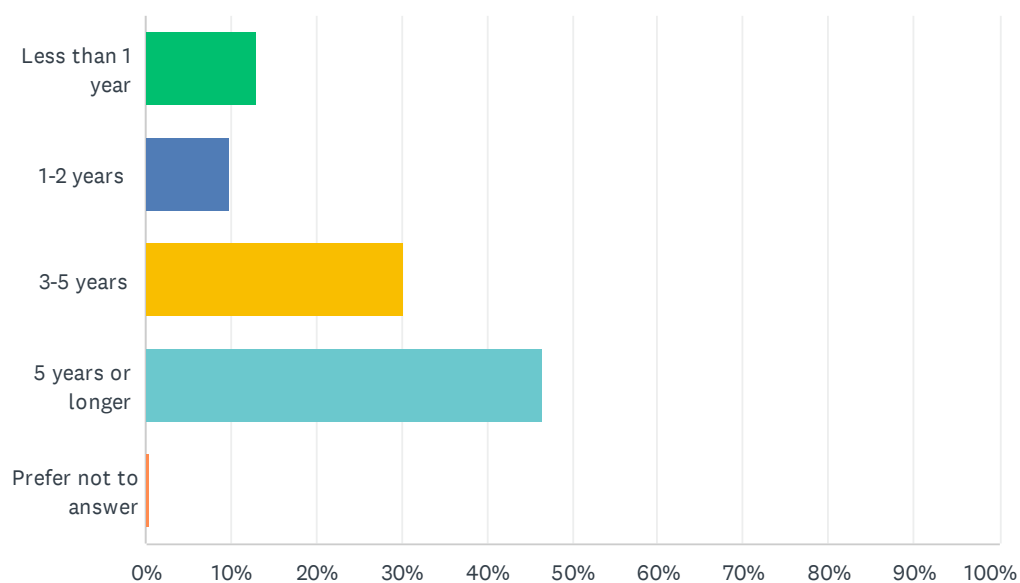


Q1 How long have you been a member of Osher at UR?

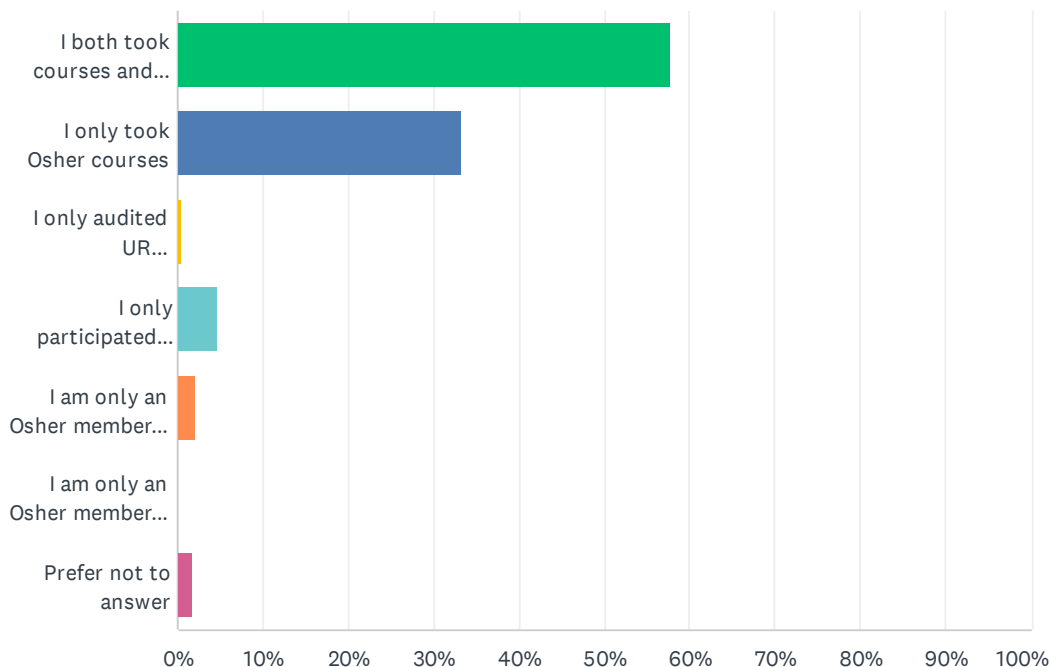

Q2 Which of the following best describes your involvement in Osher at UR over the past 2 years?

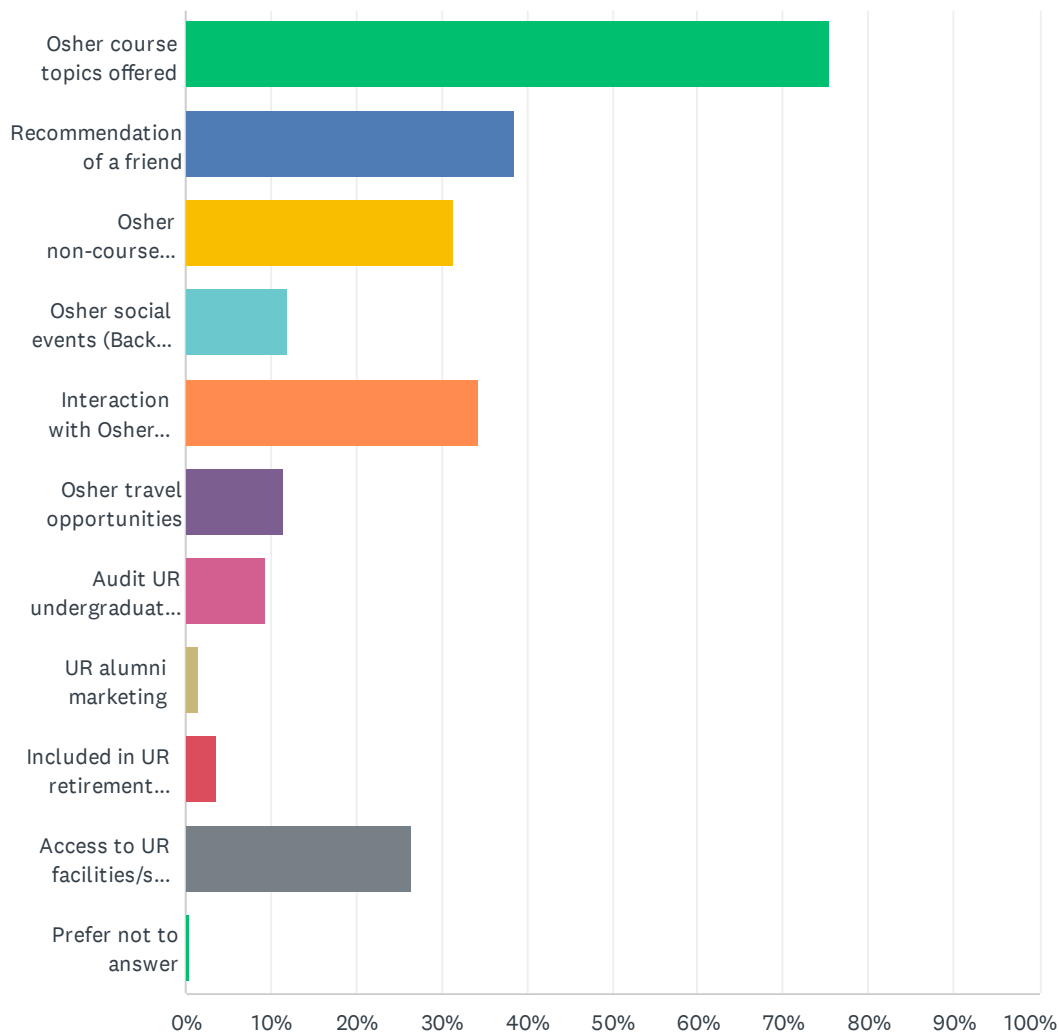

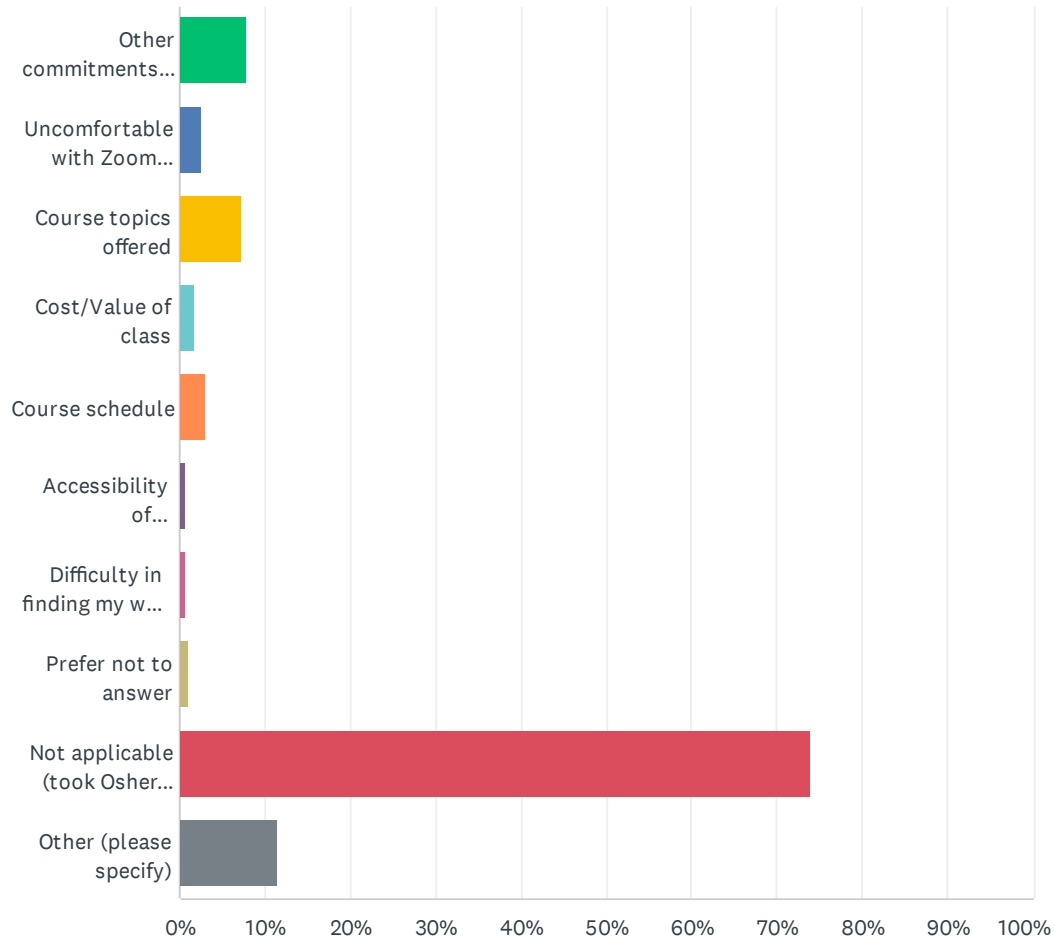

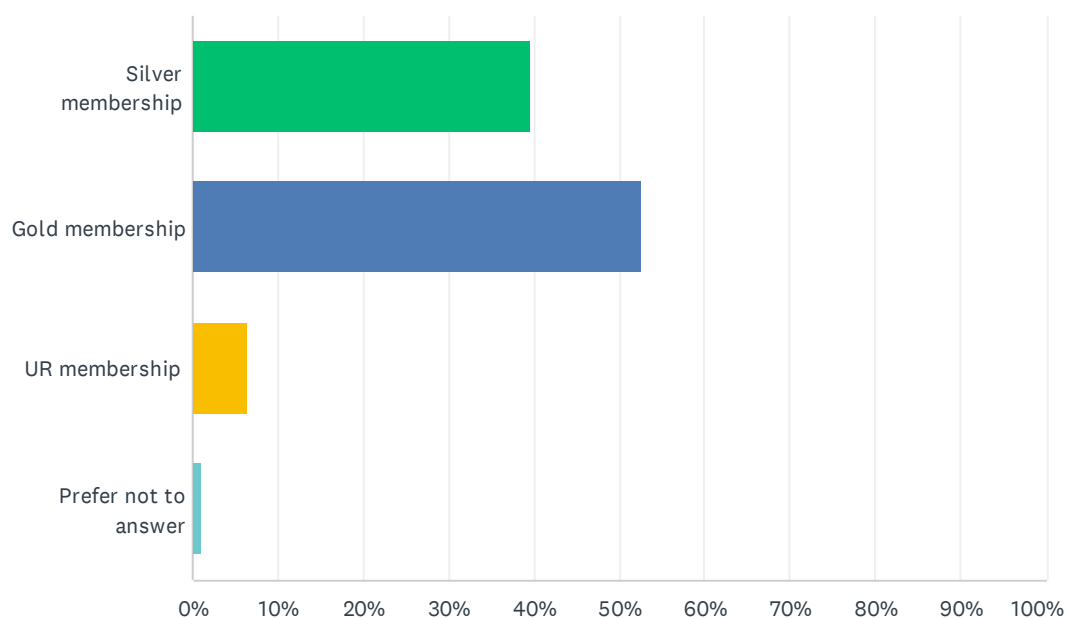

Q5 What type of membership do you have at present?

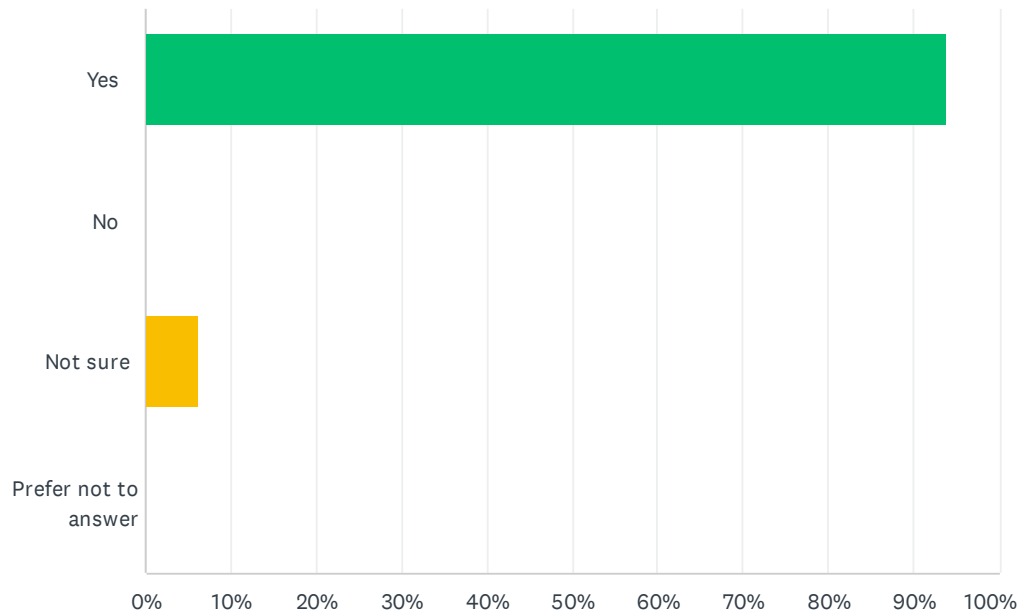

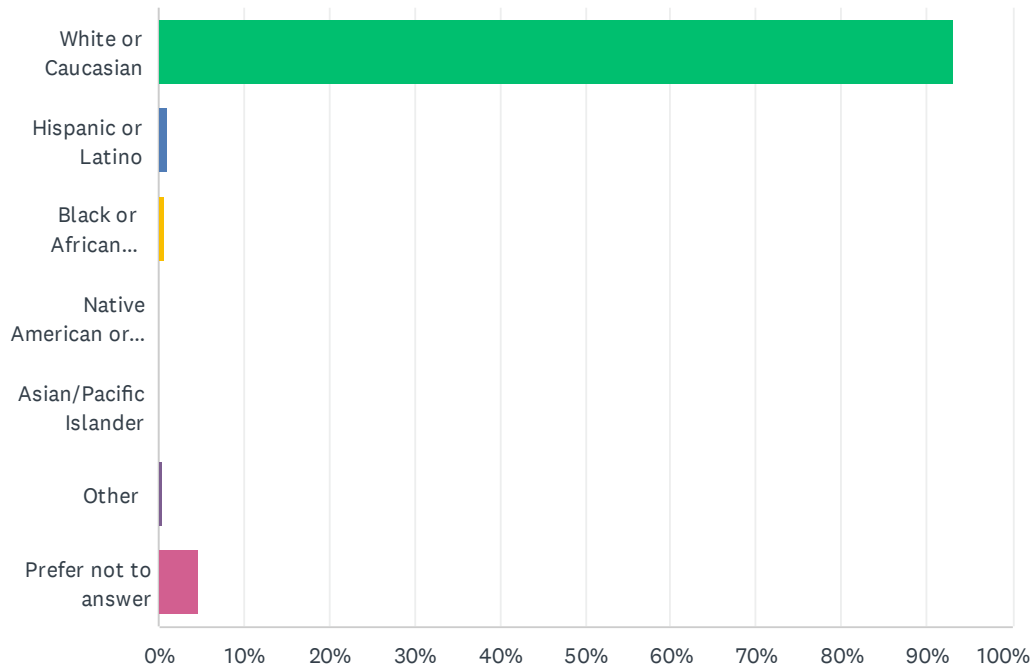

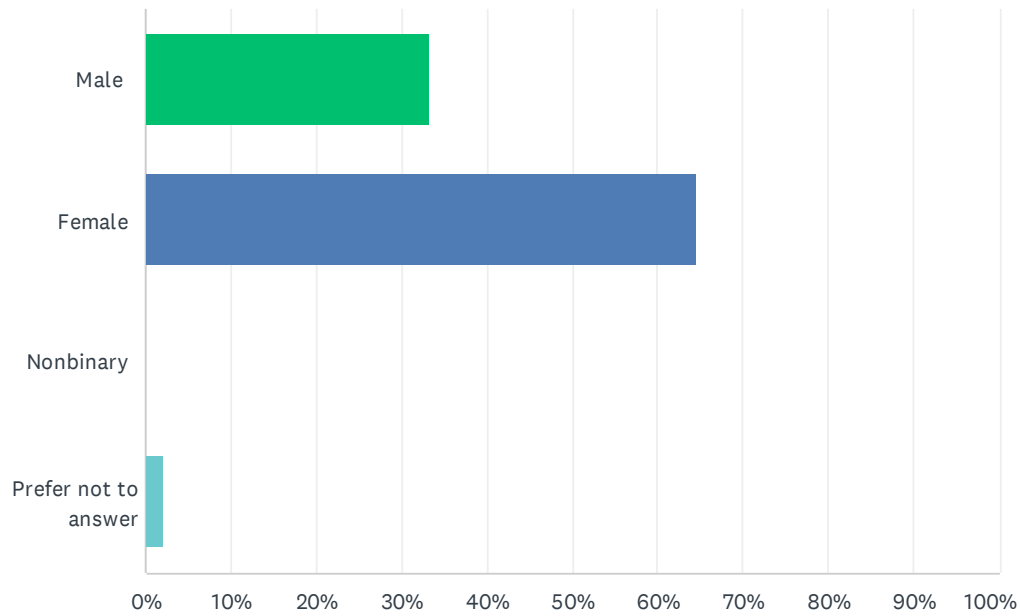

Q13 What is your gender?

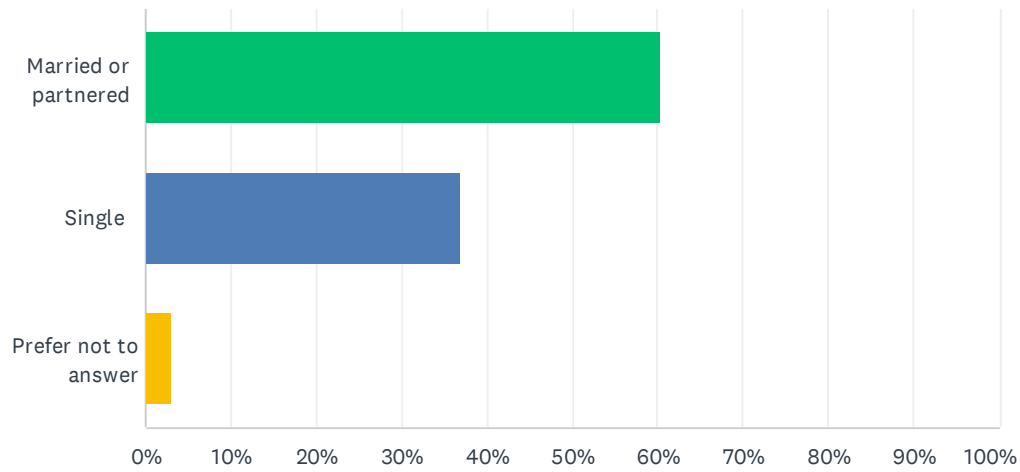

Q14 What is your current marital status?

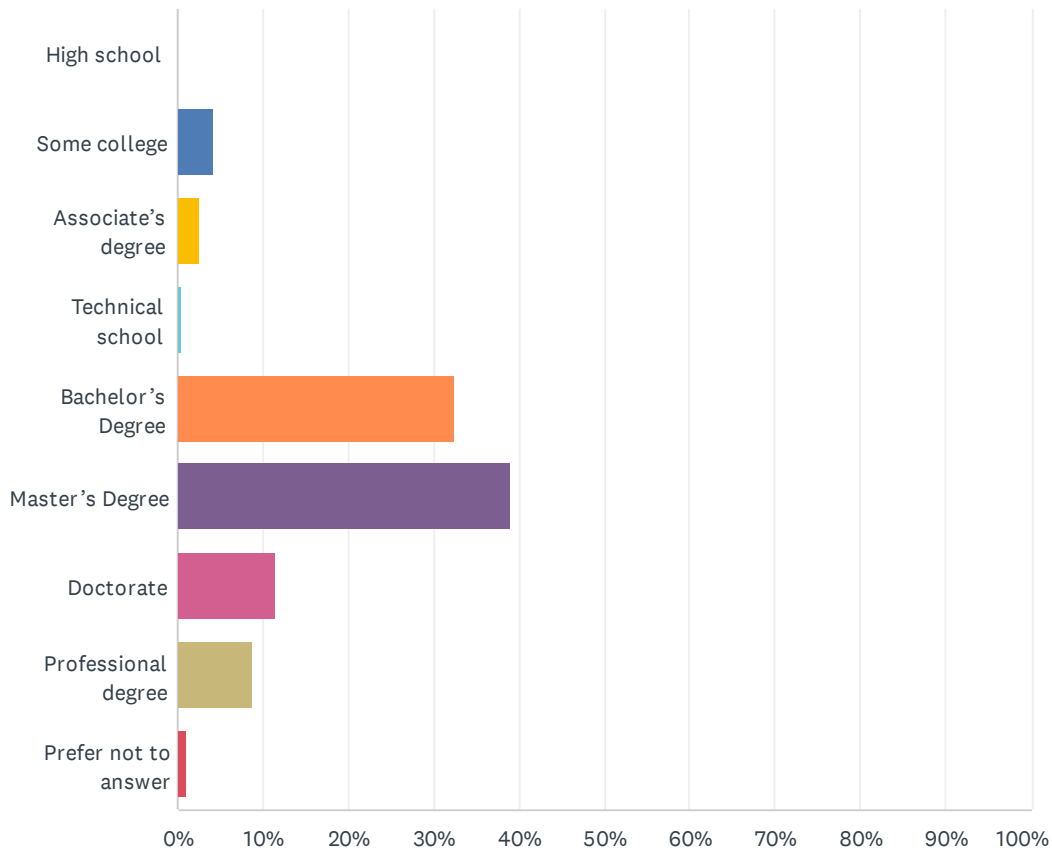

Q15 What is the highest level of school that you have completed?

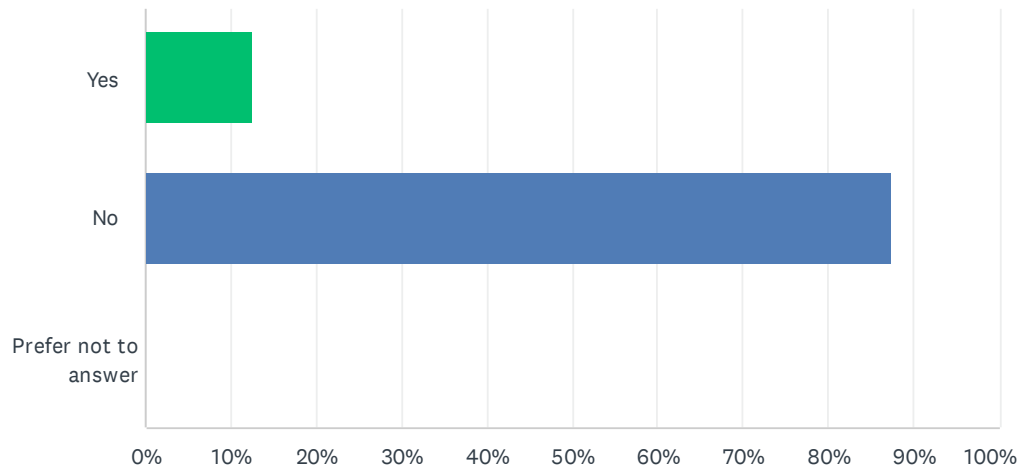

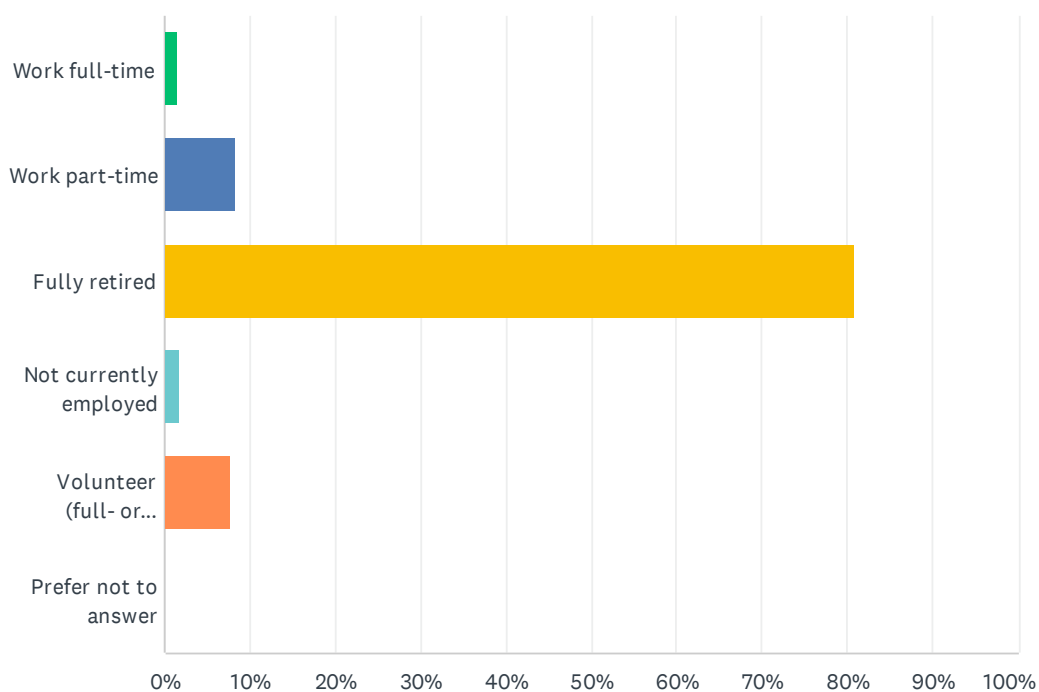

Q17 What is your current employment status?

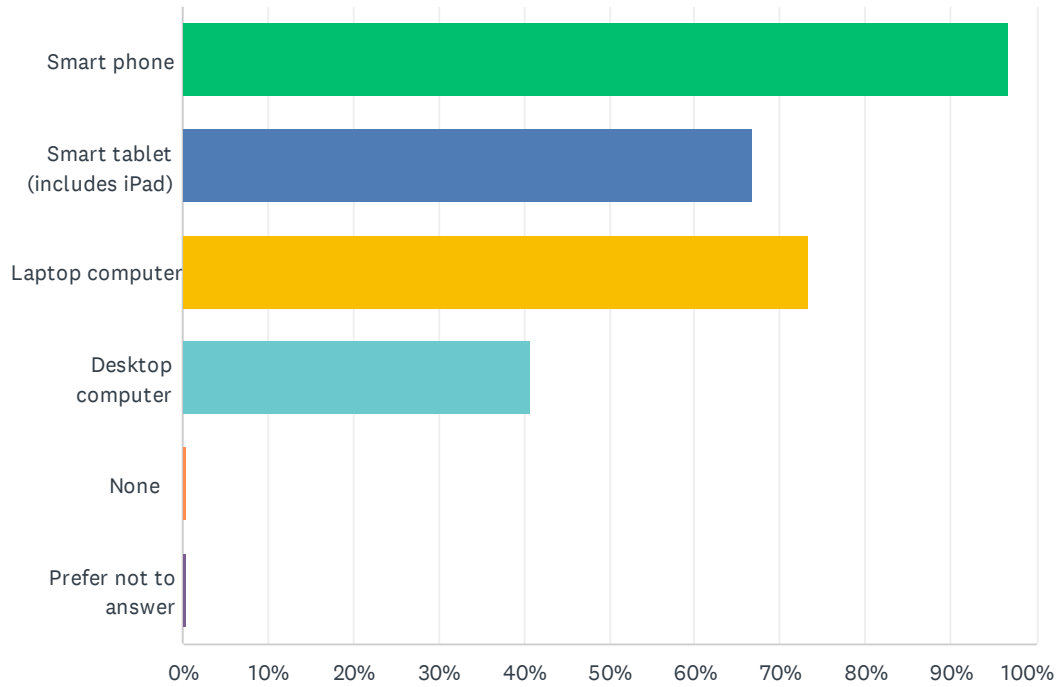

Q18 What types of electronic devices do you routinely use? (Check all that apply)

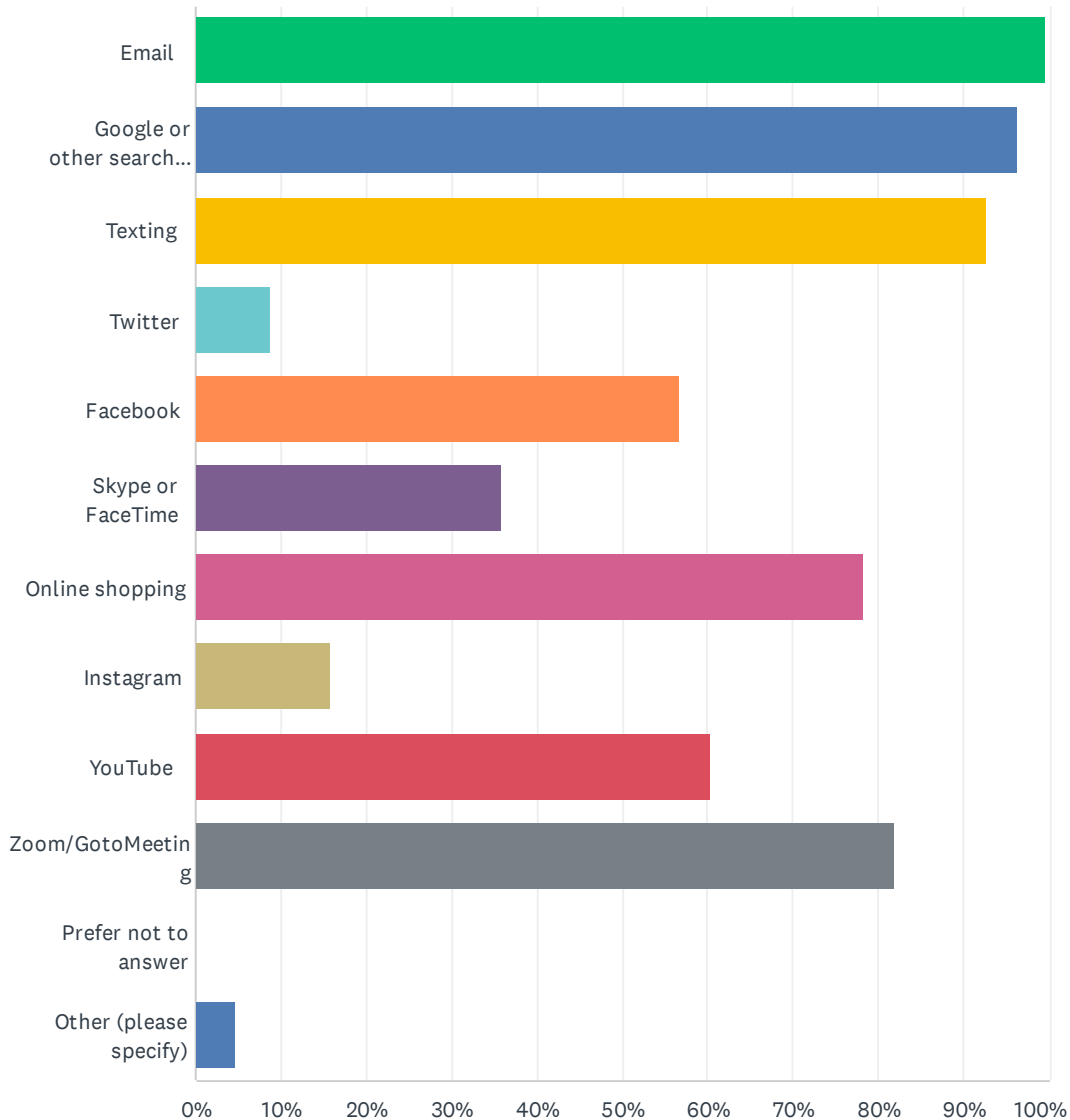

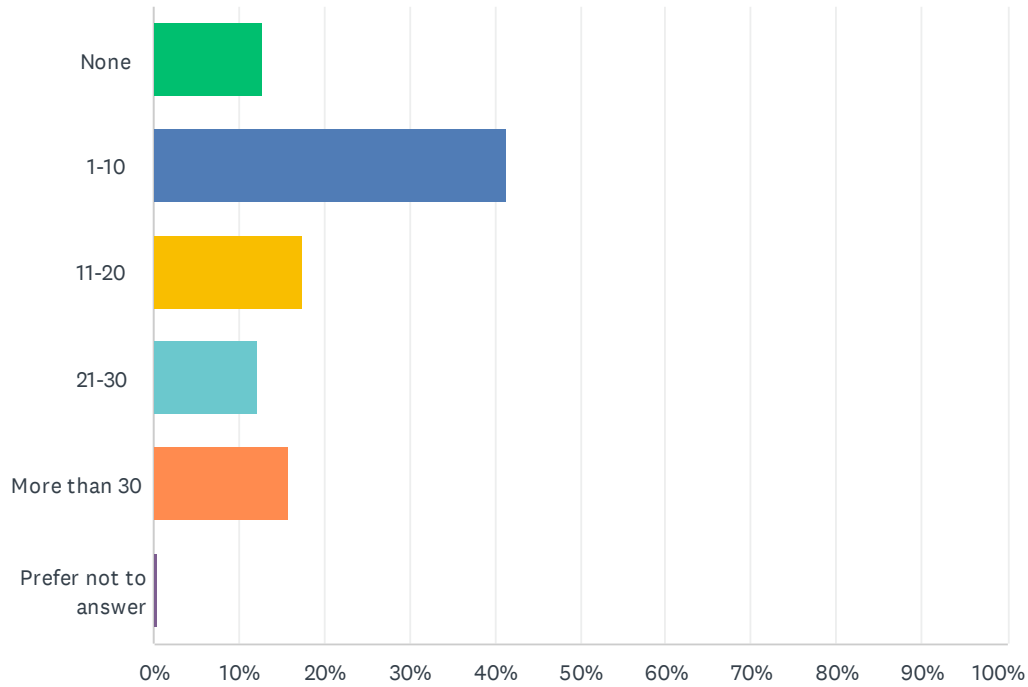

Q20 Approximately how many Osher courses did you take over the last year?

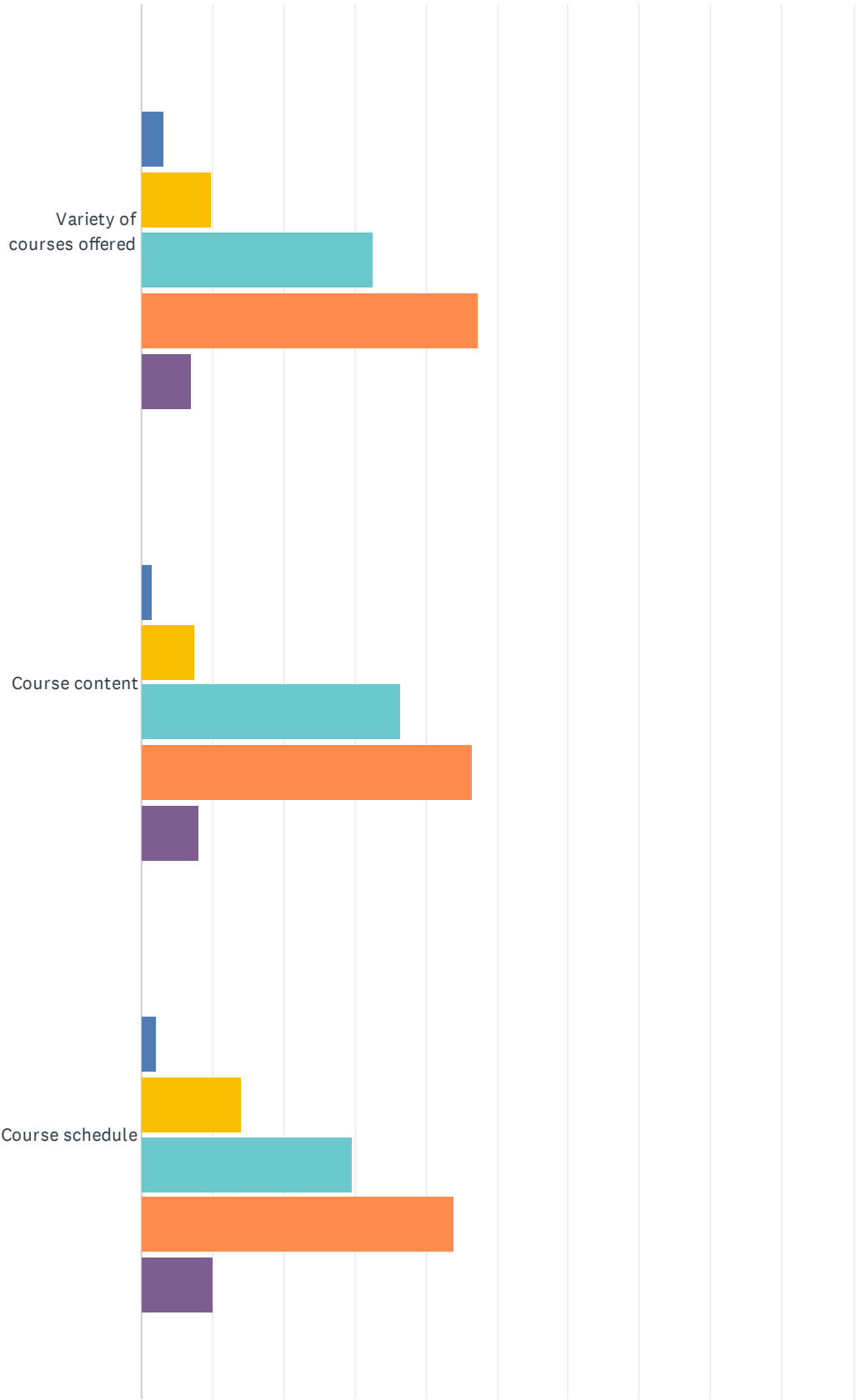

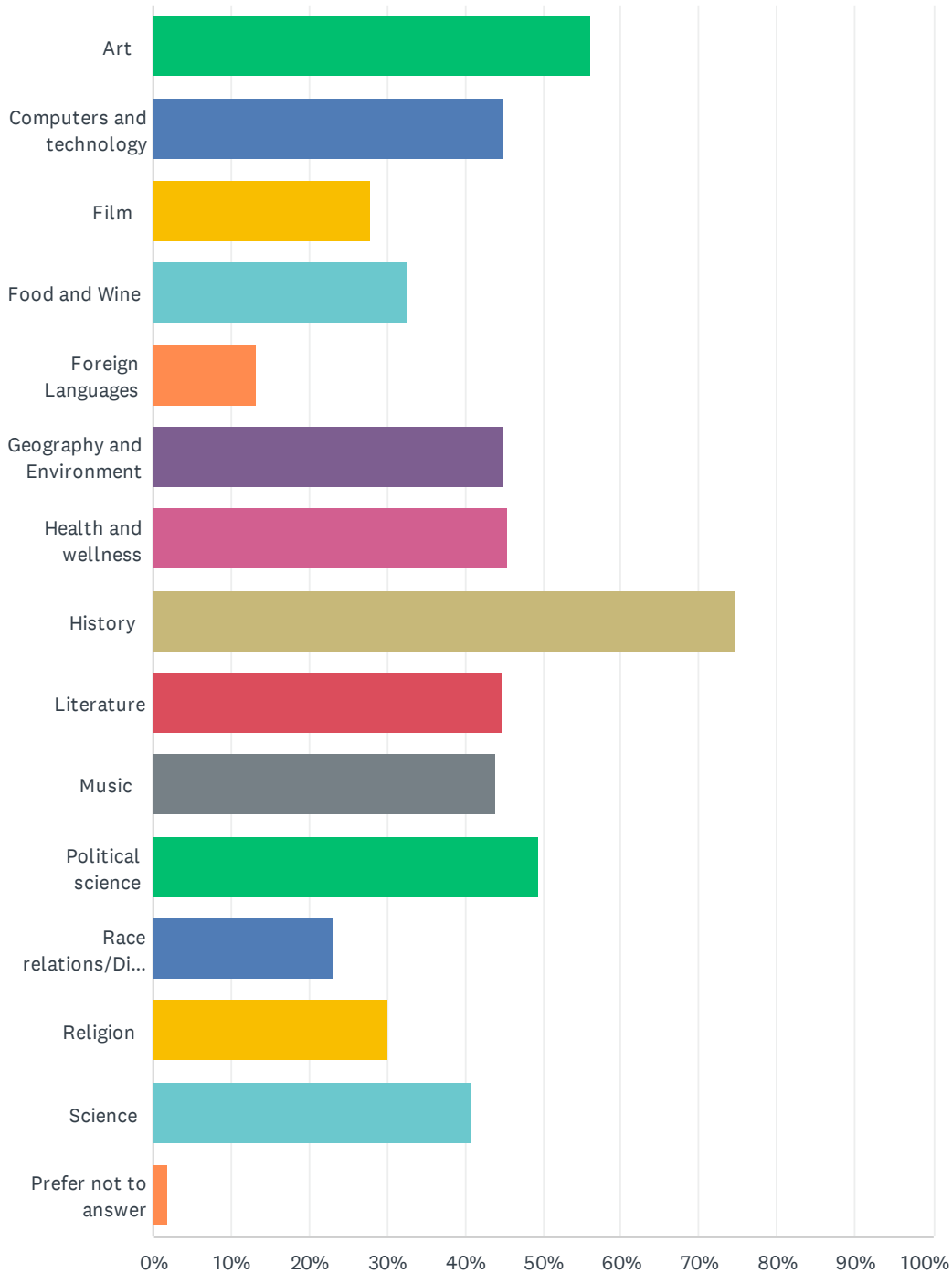

Q24 Which delivery method best describes how you have taken Osher courses over the past year?

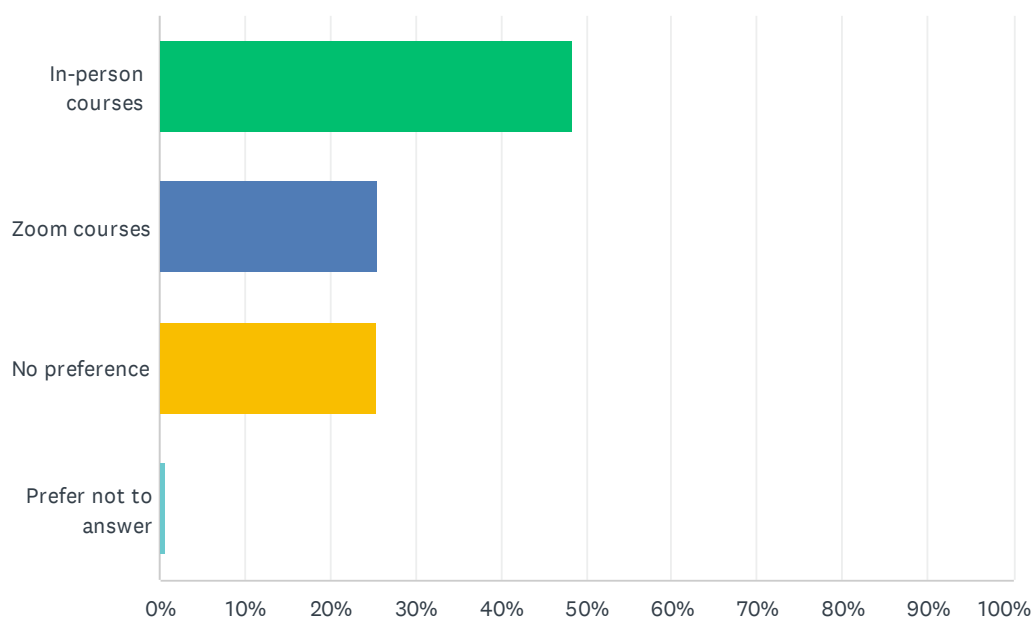

Q25 What is your preferred learning approach?

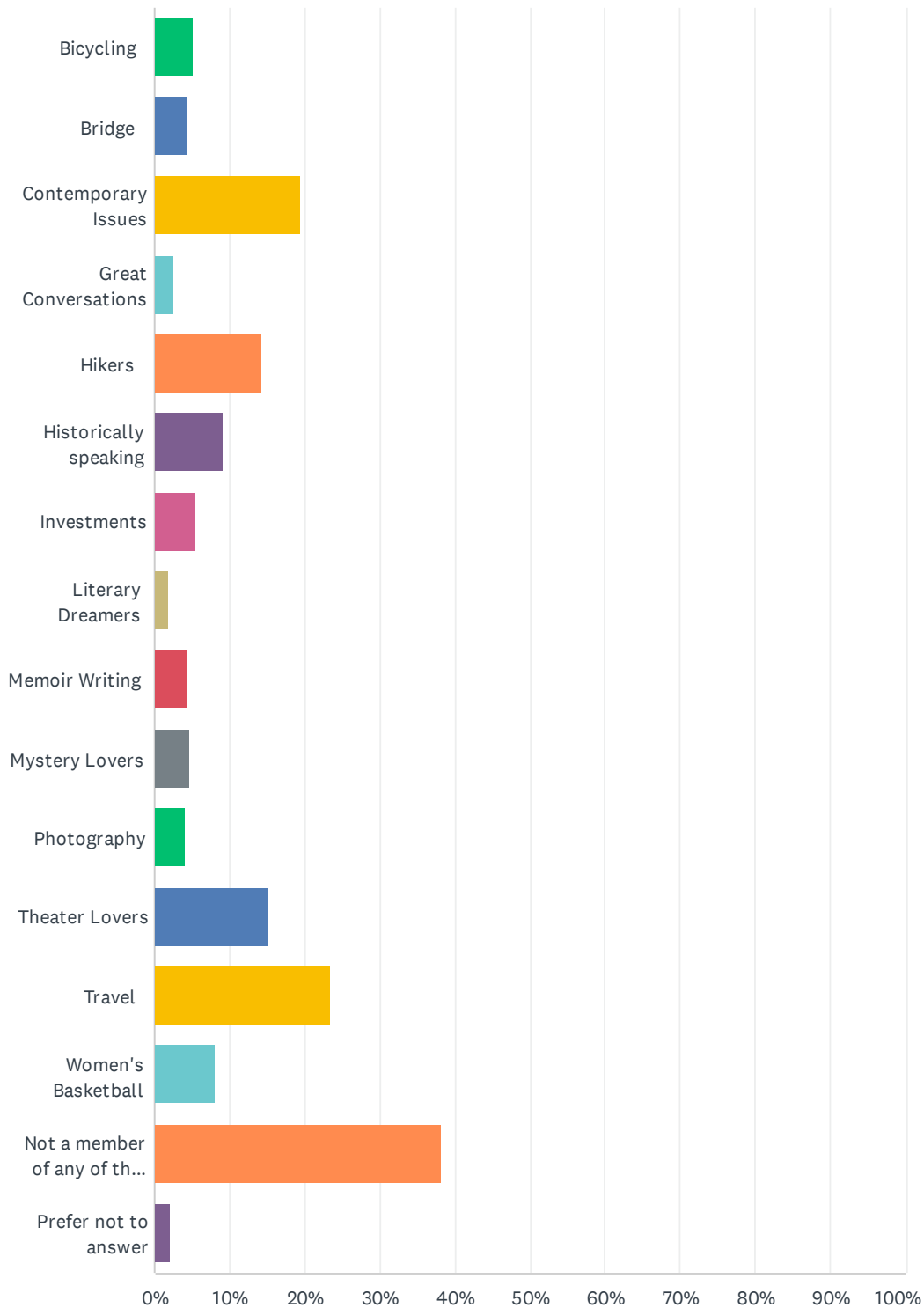

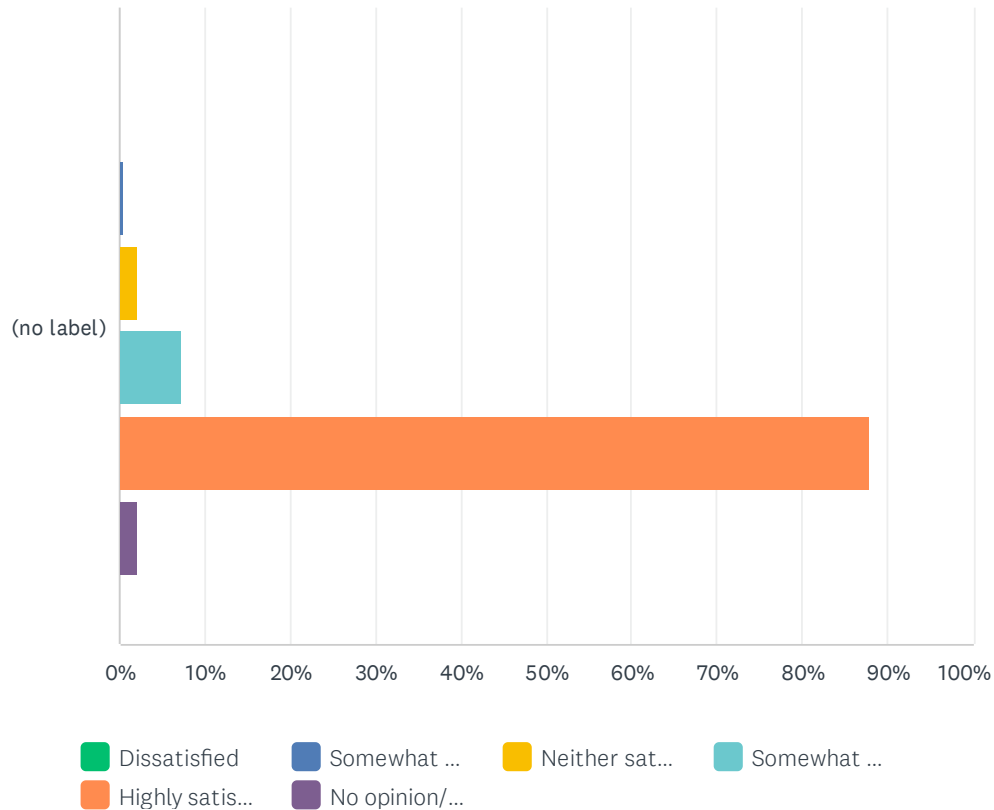
