#### Day 1 • Depart U.S.

Depart for your overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland.

#### Day 2 • Arrive in Dublin, Ireland

Arrive in Dublin, then meet travelers from our *Scottish Highlands and Lowlands: Edinburgh, St. Andrews, National Parks & Glasgow* pretrip extension.

### Day 3 • Dublin • Discover 14 Henrietta Street Museum
